

# AFL CLUBHELP WEBINAR SERIES PRIZE PROMOTION

## TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Information on how to enter and prizes form part of these Conditions of Entry. Participation in this competition is deemed acceptance of these Terms and Conditions.
2. Entry is open to all ordinary Australian persons who reside in Australia and are registered or otherwise aligned with a community football club ("Club") affiliated in accordance with clause 3 ("Eligible Entrants"). Entrants under 18 years of age must have parental/guardian approval to enter and further, the parent/guardian of the entrant must read and consent to these Terms and Conditions. Parents/guardians may be required by the Promoter to enter into a further agreement as evidence of consent to the minor entering this competition.
3. To be eligible for a prize, the Club of an Eligible Entrant must be affiliated to one of the following Australian Football State / Territory controlling bodies: AFL NSW/ACT, AFL Northern Territory, AFL Queensland, AFL Tasmania, AFL Victoria, South Australian National Football League and Western Australian Football Commission.
4. Employees (and their immediate families) of the Promoter, participating outlets and the agencies associated with this promotion are ineligible to enter this competition. Immediate family means any of the following: spouse, ex-spouse child or step-child (whether natural or by adoption), parent, step-parent.
5. Competition commences on 01/02/2023 at 09:00am AEDT and closes on 29/03/2023 at 11:59pm AEDT (the "Competition Period").
6. To enter this competition, Eligible Entrants must during the Competition Period register for and attend at least one webinar as promoted within the "2023 AFL ClubHelp Webinar Series" ("Webinars") available via the link on [www.play.afl/learn](http://www.play.afl/learn). "Attendance" will be classified as dialling in to listen/watch the webinar(s) via the calendar invitation link supplied by the Promoter to one or more of the respective webinar topics listed in clause 6.

These webinar topics are accurate at the time of commencement of the Competition Period, however the Promoter reserves the right to alter the names of any topic, remove a topic and/or add a new topic to the webinar series. 8. The Promoter reserves the right, at any time, to invalidate any entries (and entrants who submit or cause those entries to be submitted) which it reasonably suspects have been

submitted: (a) using false, incorrect, fraudulent or misleading information, including but not limited to personal details and contact information; (b) through the use of multiple identities, email addresses or accounts; and/or (c) in any way in contravention of these Terms and Conditions.

9. Incomplete, illegible, or incorrect entries, or those which contain offensive or defamatory comments, or which breach any law or infringe any third-party rights, including intellectual property rights, will be deemed invalid.
10. If there is a dispute as to the identity of an Eligible Entrant, the Promoter reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to determine the identity of the Eligible Entrant.
11. The Promoter reserves the right, at any time during, or after the closing date of the competition, to verify the validity of entries and Eligible Entrants (including an Eligible Entrant's identity and place of residence) and to disqualify any Eligible Entrant who submits an entry that is not in accordance with these Terms and Conditions or who tampers with the entry process. Failure by the Promoter to enforce any of its rights at any stage does not constitute a waiver of those rights.
12. Entries are deemed to be received at the time of receipt into the Promoter's competition database and NOT at the time of completion by the Eligible Entrant. Any cost associated with entering the competition is the Eligible Entrant's responsibility.
13. The draw will take place at AFL House, 140 Harbour Esplanade, Docklands 3008 (or a remote location determined by the Promoter) on 30/03/2023 at 11:00am AEDT. The prize winners will be notified via email within 2 days of the selection to organise the claiming of their prize. The result of the draw is final and no correspondence will be entered into. The winners' names will be published on AFL social media pages from the day that the prize winners are selected.
14. This is a contest of chance – with winners drawn at random from all eligible entries.
15. Up to twenty-five (25) prizes will be awarded. There is a limit of one (1) prize per Eligible Entrant. The prizes include:

a. **Major Prize:** Each Eligible Entrant who registers and attends ALL Webinars will go in the draw to receive:

- i. One \$5,000 cash prize for their affiliated Club (one prize only); and
- ii. One \$250 e-gift for each Eligible Entrant from their Affiliated Club (up to a maximum of 8 x \$250 e-gifts).

The major prize-winning Club will provide to the Promoter the bank account and contact details for their nominated Club.

The winning Eligible Entrants will have their e-gift transferred to them via their mobile and email details supplied during Competition or Webinar registration.

b. **Minor Prizes:** Each Eligible Entrant who registers and attends at least one (*but not all*) Webinar will go in the draw to receive:

- i. One \$250 e-gift for their affiliated Club (7 x \$250 e-gifts in total); and
- ii. One \$250 e-gift (7 x \$250 e-gifts in total).

The minor prize-winning clubs will provide to the Promoter the bank account and contact details for a club representative to receive the e-gift on behalf of their nominated club.

The winning Eligible Entrants will have their e-gift transferred via their mobile and email details supplied when registering for the webinar.

16. The total prize pool is valued at \$10,500.00.
17. If for any reason a winner does not take the prize or any part of the prize at the time stipulated by the Promoter, then the prize or that part of the prize cannot be transferred, exchanged or redeemed for cash.
18. Prizes, or any unused portion of a prize, are not transferable or exchangeable.
19. If this promotion is interfered with in any way or is not capable of being conducted as reasonably anticipated due to any reason beyond the reasonable control of the Promoter, the Promoter reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to the fullest extent permitted by law:
  - (a) To disqualify any Eligible Entrant; or
  - (b) Subject to any written directions from a regulatory authority, to modify, suspend, terminate or cancel the promotion, as appropriate.
20. If any prize (or part of any prize) is unavailable, the Promoter, in its discretion, reserves the right to substitute the prize (or that part of the prize) with a prize to the equal value and/or specification, subject to any written directions from a regulatory authority.
21. Nothing in these Terms and Conditions limits, excludes or modifies or purports to limit, exclude or modify the statutory consumer guarantees as provided under the Competition and Consumer Act, as well as any other implied warranties under the ASIC Act or similar consumer protection laws in the States and Territories of Australia ("Non-Excludable Guarantees"). Except for any liability that cannot by law be excluded, including the Non-Excludable Guarantees, the Promoter (including its respective officers, employees and agents) exclude all liability (including negligence), for any personal injury or death; or any loss or damage (including loss of opportunity); whether direct, indirect, special or consequential, arising in any way out of the promotion or accepting or using the prize.
22. The Promoter reserves the right to request that the winner provide proof of identity prior to awarding the prize. Identification considered suitable for verification is at the discretion of the Promoter. Prize winner may be required to sign any form required by the Promoter including without limitation a legal release and indemnity form or a declaration confirming their eligibility to accept the prize.

If for any reason this competition is not capable of running as planned, including due to infection by computer virus, bugs, tampering, unauthorised intervention, fraud, technical failures or any causes beyond the control of the Promoter, which corrupt or affect the administration, security, fairness or integrity or proper conduct of this promotion, the Promoter reserves the right in its sole discretion to disqualify any individual who tampers with the entry process, take any action that may be available, and to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the competition any changes are subject to State Regulations.
29. Eligible Entrants consent to the Promoter using the Eligible Entrant's name, likeness, image and/or voice (including photograph, film and/or recording of the same) in any media for an unlimited period without remuneration for the purpose of promoting this competition (including any outcome), and promoting any products manufactured, distributed and/or supplied by the Promoter.

All entries and materials submitted to the Promoter in connection with this competition (in any form including without limitation in hard copy or electronic form) become and remain the property of the Promoter and each Eligible Entrant warrants it has the right to transfer these things to the Promoter. The Promoter may collect Eligible Entrants' personal information in order to conduct the promotion. If the information requested is not provided, the Eligible Entrant may not participate in the promotion. By providing your personal information, you agree to such use by the Promoter.
38. The competition is governed exclusively by the laws of Australia.
